

Shelf Talker: Why is it Important to Share Your Opinion?

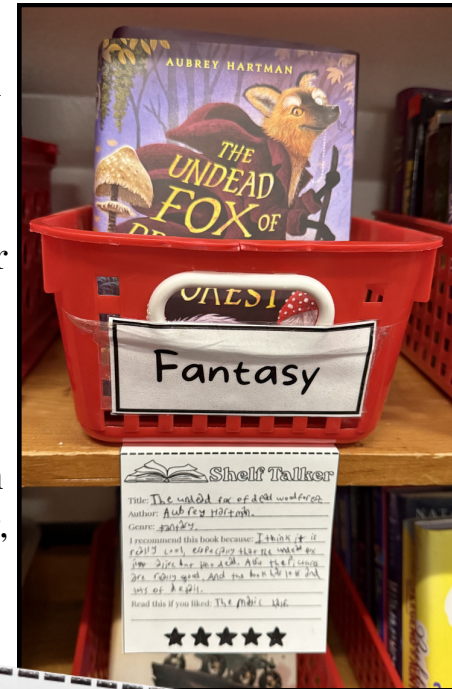

As a student who reads, it is important for you to share your opinion. You should share your opinion with other people so they will find new books to read. When you recommend a book that you like, other people might get that book and try to see if they like it. And if they do, great! You just helped someone find a new book or maybe even a series! If they don't, well that's perfectly fine too, they might not like some of the things that you like because, you know, not everyone is the same.

With a Shelf Talker, you can share your opinion and recommend a book that you really enjoyed. You can also share another book that might have a similar background, or maybe one that is by the same author, or more books of that genre (Fantasy, Horror, Romance, Comedy, etc.). Then, it will most likely help them find new books that they will like.

And just think, if you recommend a book to someone and they end up liking it they will probably share their opinion about it to other people. That means more people finding great books that are a good fit!

Using your voice can be scary at times, but it is important that you do because it can really help other people who are in need of a suggestion, and sharing your opinion encourages other people to use their voice, too!
